- **Usage of social networking for updates on events** – As usual, our message on new events will be circulated to YOU through LSE emails, Facebook and Twitter

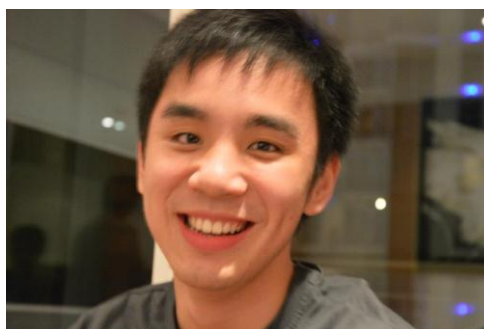

Hello everyone! I'm Xin Yuun and I'm a first year undergraduate doing Actuarial Science. I'm running for the position of Project Director.

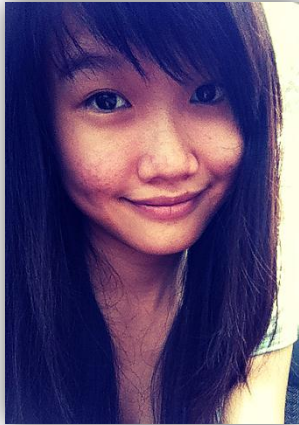
Why me?

Be supportive of company goals to forge strategic alliances and sustainable partnerships. Foster economic development, provide needed tools to find solutions, professional education, and technology transfer.

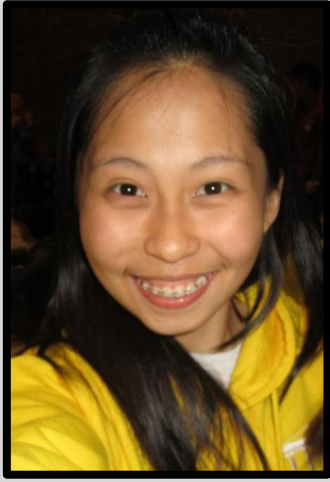
